XBMC4STB Roadmap



XBMC4STB is a long-term project of Vu+. Vu+ aims to develop XBMC4STB as a future-proof open platform that can be used for multimedia player and set top box.

• By 1st Quarter of 2012

The first beta version will be publicly released to various communities interested in this new platform. Vu+ will actively communicate with these communities and offer as much support as possible to make sure that the development process is fun and efficient.

• By 2nd Quarter of 2012

By this stage, XBMC4STB will be ported into a new breed of multimedia player device. Volunteers will have an actual hardware device via which they can easily try out new concepts of applications and add-ons.

• By 3rd Quarter of 2012

A completely new XBMC software integrating DVB in full extent will be released publicly by this stage, opening exciting chances for volunteers of XBC4STB communities.
